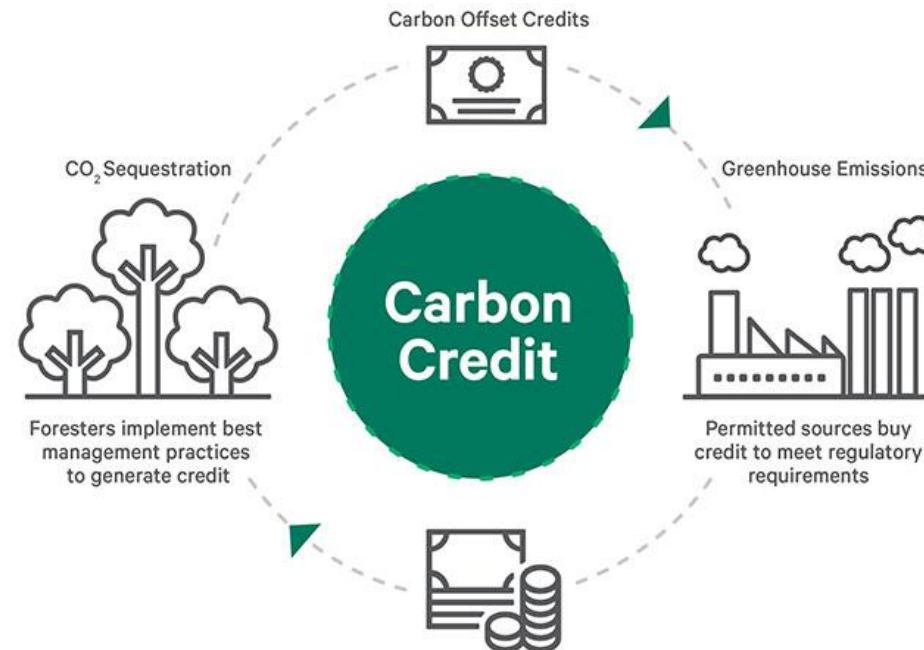

What are Carbon Credits?

BALANCING GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

A carbon credit is a tradeable certificate representing the right to emit one ton of CO₂ or the equivalent of another greenhouse gas, secured by practices that offset the same amount of CO₂, such as the management of natural forests and lands.

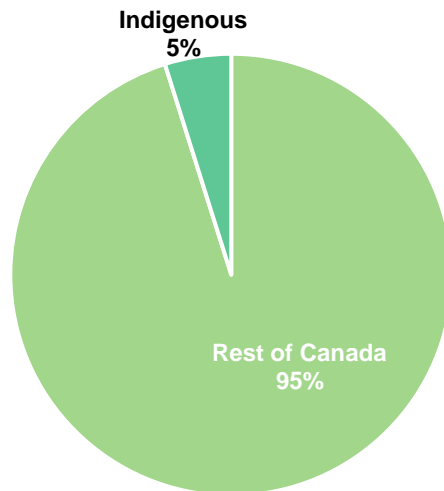

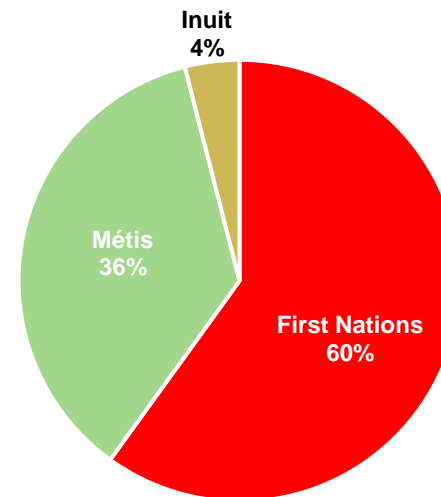
CANADIAN POPULATION DATA
